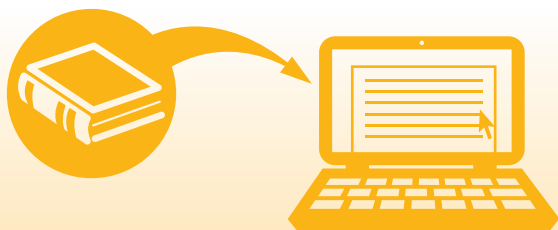

計劃目標 Goals and Objectives

為閱讀殘障學生提供各類支援服務，協助他們善用電子模式學習，藉此消除他們與一般學生在學習上的差距。

To bridge the learning gap between students with and without disabilities by providing various kinds of supportive services for print disabled students so that they can make the best use of e-learning in their academic pursuit.

服務對象 Target

- 閱讀殘障學生，包括以下的殘障類別：
 - 視力障礙
 - 肢體殘障 (無法手持書本或翻頁)
 - 讀寫障礙
- 有關學生的家長及老師
- 向有閱讀殘障學生提供服務之機構
- Students with print disabilities, including:
 - visual impairment
 - physical impairment (unable to hold or manipulate a book)
 - dyslexia
- Their parents and teachers
- Agencies serving students with print disabilities

服務內容 Services Content

製作無障礙電子及觸覺教材

Production of learning materials in accessible electronic and tactile format

- 將中、小學課程的教科書、參考書及教材轉換成可供閱讀殘障學生閱讀的電子 / 觸覺版本。
- To convert the textbooks, reference books and other learning materials of primary and secondary levels into accessible electronic / tactile format for students with print disabilities.

培訓及支援

Training and support

- 向有需要的學生、家長及教師提供相關的技術支援及顧問服務。
- To provide technical support and consultation service to needy students, parents and teachers on the use of assistive devices in e-learning.

Assistive aids research and development

- 檢視最新的輔助科技，研發適合閱讀殘障學生的學習軟件。
- To evaluate latest technical aids and develop suitable software for the use of the target students.
